



April 2018, RiverRun Cabinetry added a Full Access cabinet line to their current framed cabinet offerings. This new line features two shaker door styles: **Sutton Sandstone** and **Sutton Driftwood** (pictured below) with a textured laminate finish and comes fully assembled.

WHAT IS FULL ACCESS CABINETRY?

Frameless cabinetry is sometimes called "Full Access" cabinetry because it offers greater accessibility by eliminating the face frame. Instead, it relies on thicker box construction for stability. Only full overlay doors can be used, with hinges attached directly to the sides of the cabinet box. Full Access is common in Europe and often comes in more contemporary door styles.

Full Access cabinets are great for any home, but it is especially helpful in certain environments and situations:

- Small homes: Frameless styles were first established in Europe where small housing is the standard. The structure allows for space savings when it really counts.
- Multi-units: Apartments, hotels, assisted-living and student housing are perfect for Full Access cabinetry. If cabinet faces become damaged due to abuse or heavy use, it is easier to simply change the doors and drawers rather than the entire cabinet. The same is true for updating to a fresh style.





MIX & MATCH STYLES

It is no accident that RiverRun chose a shaker door style as their first design in the Full Access line.

Even though the frameless wall cabinets are 1" deeper, you can mix-n-match with our other shaker styles in the framed cabinets.

The wood textures in the Sutton line can offer a beautiful accent to some of our painted and stained shaker styles from our classic, framed cabinet line.

END PANELS


End panels on Full Access Cabinets provides a modern, smooth look. Frameless cabinets with the edges of doors and drawers butted nearly flush provide an elegant, sleek look in a kitchen—a look that is impossible to achieve with framed cabinets where frames are always visible.

The white melamine box construction allows for space savings when it's really needed but exposed end cabinets will always need an end panel for a finished look.

All end panels are ³/₄" thick and extend out flush with the drawer and door fronts.

Base end panels extend to the floor and are not notched at the toe kick similar to high-end frameless cabinetry.

Care & Maintenance

With proper care, Sutton cabinets will maintain their beautiful color and texture for many years. Generally, a damp sponge is all you need for everyday maintenance of laminate surfaces.

Basic Cleaning

Use a soft cloth to wash the surface with warm water and a mild dishwashing detergent. Rinse with warm water and dry with a soft cloth. Use an all-purpose cleaner or bathroom cleanser to remove spots and stains.

Avoid harsh chemicals and abrasives to keep the textured surface looking beautiful for many years to come.

CASE

• White melamine box that utilizes end panels for a finished look. End panels are 3/4" thick.

DOOR/DRAWER REVEALS

- Wall cabinet doors have a 1/16" reveal on all sides. 1/8" between doors.
- Base cabinet doors have a 1/16" reveal on all sides. 1/8" between double doors and between doors/drawers.

DOOR CLEARANCE

• As with all full access door styles, clearance of doors and drawers must be taken into consideration during the design process to assure proper operation of all doors and drawers.


SINGLE DOOR CABINET HINGING

• Single Door Cabinets are universally hinged on the right side. These doors may be reversed in the field as needed.
